BY THE NUMBERS

Class and lesson enrollment saw modest growth, with the most notable increase in the Music Together® Early Childhood program. We expanded Music Together® class offerings, which now include a "Babies" class, "Mixed Age" classes for 6 mo.- 5 yrs., "Rhythm Kids" for ages 4-8, and "Big Kids" for ages 5-7. Financial aid requests and awards increased to an all-time high this year, and our generous donors stepped up to meet the need.





EDUCATIONAL OUTREACH INITIATIVE

Music and the arts play a pivotal role in completing a well-rounded education. It is widely acknowledged that school programs such as these are on the front line of budget cuts, with music classes constantly stripped down or cut entirely. In 2017-2018 we continued to build on our outreach partnerships with Broadview Thomson K-8 and Northgate Elementary, both Title I schools, by providing over 120 hours of classroom hours of instrumental instruction at no cost to the school or students.
